Thie event took place over two days at the Medical University of Vienna.




Our liMER workshop grant awardees (left) - Jordan (UK), Aline (Netherlands) and Hanna (Poland) are pictured here.

- a series of TV programmes that we were assisting - 'conveying the suffering and lack of action regarding ME'

and the Gibson Inquiry into ME
 We also had a "ME and My MP" campaign - an attempt to inform MPs of the issues with ME.
 Quite ironic when one sees our parliamentary briefing attempt above trying to do the same thing twenty years later.
